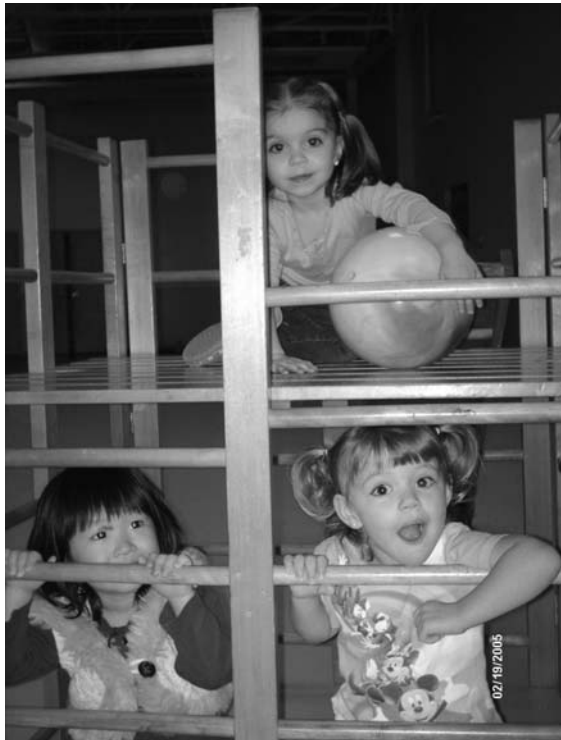

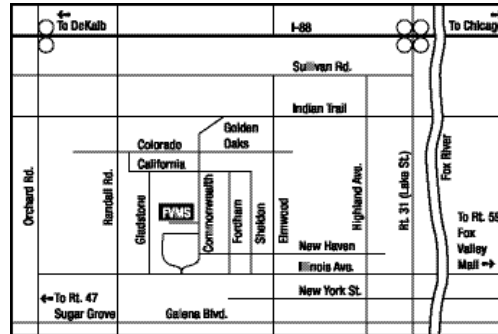

Education

The Parent-Infant Class provides learning experiences for both parents and infants, from birth to 18 months. The children learn from an environment which is rich in opportunities to explore. At the same time, parents learn from their exposure to other parents, to others' children, and to the helpful guidance of the teacher.

Our classroom is an appealing, comfortable environment designed to meet the changing needs of infants through 18 months. Infants and toddlers are learning all the time: learning to move and control their bodies, exploring and experimenting, observing and making sense of the world around them.

Parent education is a very important aspect of the Parent-Infant class. Parents have the regular opportunity to focus on their child, expanding their ability to observe. They can make note of their child's activity to gain a better understanding of the child. Observation is the basis of the Montessori method of education, as well as for study in all areas of child development. We will dedicate the last portion of each class to a discussion of topics of interest to the parents in attendance. This time may also be used to discuss any questions that arise during the course of their observations during the class.
